## *Immunization Rules for 6th Grade*

Georgia law requires all children entering school or daycare to show proof of immunization.

ALL CHILDREN ENTERING 6TH GRADE (ON OR AFTER JULY 1, 2007) ARE REQUIRED TO MEET THE FOLLOWING **NEW REQUIREMENTS:**

**To DO:**

- Two (2) doses of Measles vaccine given on or after the first birthday and at least 4 weeks apart or a positive serology, two (2) doses of Mumps vaccine, and one (1) dose of Rubella vaccine or laboratory proof of immunity against Measles, Mumps, or Rubella (MMR).
- Two (2) doses of Varicella (Chicken Pox), documentation of the disease by a health care provider's interpretation of a parent's description of disease, or positive serology. (At the time your child first entered school only 1 dose of this vaccine was required.)
- Please contact your health care provider to receive any needed vaccinations and to obtain the Georgia Certificate of Immunization (Form 3231).
- **VACCINATE YOUR CHILDREN EARLY AND BEAT THE BACK TO SCHOOL RUSH!**
