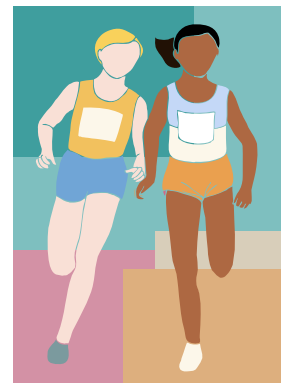
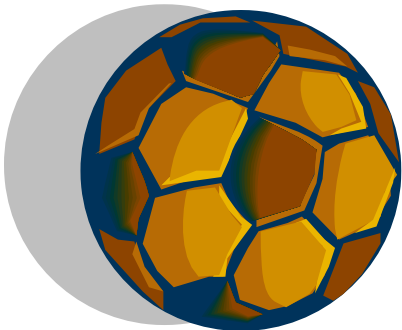

INTRAMURAL SPORTS MISSION

The mission of the Dobbins Middle School intramural sports program is to provide all students an opportunity to learn and enjoy sports in a safe, non-competitive environment. The intramural program will develop fitness, leadership, and social skills in students who participate.

DOBBINS INTRAMURAL SPORTS

GENERAL GUIDELINES

- 1. Intramural sports program participants who have parent permission forms on file will sign in at gym at 7:15 and no later than 7:25 each morning.**
- 2. Parents should drop students off at the bus ramp and students should report immediately to the gym.**
- 3. Academic excellence takes precedence over the intramural sports program. Students are encouraged to attend the first portion of intramural sports and then report to tutoring or help sessions at their start times.**
- 4. Intramural Sports will end at the 8:15 bell each morning. Students must stay in the intramural sports activity area until the staff releases them.**
- 5. The Intramural Sports program is an extension of the classroom. All dress code, behavior, and safety standards apply to participants. Athletic shoes are required.**

Dobbins Intramural Sports Behavior Management Plan

Following gym rules and procedures is paramount in a good Intramural Sports program.

Intramural Sports Participants are responsible for keeping a safe environment by meeting behavior expectations and demonstrating respect for coaches and fellow students.

Failure to meet expectations will result in the following consequences to correct poor behavior:

- 1. Verbal Correction**
- 2. Time Out**
- 3. Parent Conference**
- 4. Suspension of Intramural Participation Privileges**
- 5. Referral to school administrators**

*** Acts of extreme disregard for safety, such as fighting, will result in immediate administrator referral and possible suspension of intramural participation privileges.**

INTRAMURAL STAFF GUIDELINES

- 1. The intramural director will recommend certified staff members to the principal for managing the intramural program.**
- 2. A minimum of two staff members will work each session.**
- 3. The intramural director will assign duties and be responsible for the overall supervision of all intramural sessions as well as publications and record keeping.**
- 4. Intramural staff members will work for 1 hour on days they are scheduled to be paid for a session.**
- 5. Professionalism in all aspects of intramural duties is expected by every staff member appointed to the program.**

INTRAMURAL DIRECTOR **RESPONSIBILITIES**

The Intramural Director's duties include, but are not limited to the following:

- 1. Prepare and deliver monthly attendance report (broken down by grade level).**
- 2. Maintain a list of activities by session date.**
- 3. Supervise certified intramural staff members working the intramural program.**
- 4. Maintain a database listing the number of participants by day (broken down by grade level).**
- 5. Keep a safe learning environment for all activities.**
- 6. Coordinate closely with the school's administration on all aspects of the Intramural program.**
