### **Student Expectations**

Intramurals will be held Monday through Friday from 7:15 a.m. to 8:15 a.m. in the gym. Students must arrive no later than 7:30 a.m. in order to be allowed into the gym. If students arrive prior to 7:15 a.m., they must wait outside until a teacher arrives. After 7:30 a.m., they will have to wait outside the gym until 8:15 a.m. for school to begin. Upon arrival, students will sign in every day prior to the start of their activity.

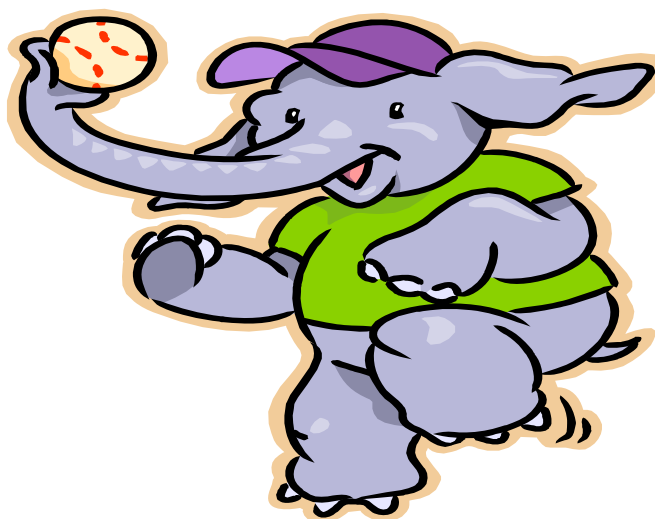
Students will not be required to dress out in P.E. attire, but appropriate school dress code and gym shoes are required. If a student wishes to change clothes, they are permitted to do so in the gym lobby restroom.

## **Behavior**

Participants are expected to adhere to the following rules:

1. Use good sportsmanship and manners.
2. Respect all students, teachers, and equipment.
3. Clean up equipment as required by the teachers after each daily activity.
4. Remain in the gym area! You are not allowed to leave until dismissal at 8:15 a.m.
5. Participation is mandatory. This is time to interact and become physically active.
6. No food, drinks, or gum are allowed in the gym.
7. Students are not allowed in the equipment room unless a teacher has given them permission.
8. All school rules are in effect during intramurals.
9. If you fail to obey the rules you will be given the following consequences:
  - a. First offense: Parent phone call and a 2 day suspension from the intramural program.
  - b. Second offense: Parent phone call and one week suspension.
  - c. Third offense: Parent phone call and removal from the program.
10. If student is in ISS for the day or suspended from the bus, they may not come to intramurals for those times.
