On Friday night, September 5th, Hiram High School accepted the first annual Superintendent's Cup for having the best overall athletic department in the school district for the 2007-2008 school year. Making the presentation was Mr. Larry Ragsdale, Superintendent of the Paulding County School District and Mr. Carl Mushrush, General Manager of Dallas Dodge-Chrysler-Jeep. Along with the presentation of the beautiful trophy, Mr. Mushrush presented Hiram High School with a check for \$500 for the general athletic fund. Dallas Dodge-Chrysler-Jeep will once again be sponsoring the Superintendent's Cup for the 2008-2009 school year.

The Cup includes the following sports in determining the annual winner: football, boys and girl's basketball, softball, boys and girls cross country, wrestling, volleyball, boys and girl's tennis, boys and girl's soccer, boys and girls track, boys and girl's golf and baseball. The point system for the Superintendent's Cup is as follows:

Those sports in which there is a county championship, points will be awarded as follows: 10 points for first, 7 points for second, 5 points for third and 2 points for fourth.

Sports in which there is no county championship will receive points as follows: Highest winning percentage in each sport receives 10 points, 2nd highest winning percentage in each sport receives 7 points, 3rd highest winning percentage in each sport receives 5 points and the 4th highest winning percentage in each sport receives 2 points.

A region championship earns a school 25 points while a region runner-up earns 15 points.

A state championship earns a school 50 points while a state runner-up earns 25 points.
