




What school does your child currently attend?











To what extent do you think your child enjoyed this school year?





Do you feel a part of your child's school community?






What is the best thing your school does to help parents become involved?








Do you think your child's teacher(s) knows how your child learns best?




How well does your child's school provide information in a parent-friendly language?






How well do staff at your child's school create a school environment that helps children learn?






I feel like I had opportunities to provide feedback and to participate in decision-making about my child's education.






How much does the school value the diversity of children's backgrounds?






Does your school explain what a School-Parent Compact is and how parents, staff, and students share the responsibility for improved student achievement?






How do you prefer to receive communication from your child's teacher and our school? Please check all that apply.






What is the best time for you to attend school events for parents?






What suggestions do you have to engage more parents from your community?




How confident are you in your ability to support your child's learning at home of what he/she is learning in the classroom?






In what ways might the school help you support your child's academic learning more effectively?










Channel by which participant accessed the survey
