This Week in First Grade

Reading: Students will describe characters, settings, and major events in a story.

Speaking and Listening: Students will follow agreed-upon rules for discussions and will express ideas and feelings clearly.

Language: Students will print in upper and lowercase letters with appropriate spacing.

Math: Students will count to 120, starting at any number less than 120.

Science: Students will observe, measure, and communicate weather data to see patterns in weather and climate.
