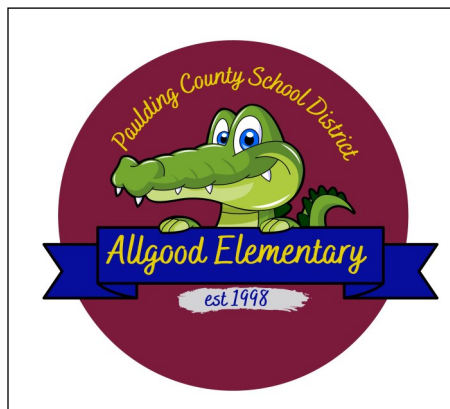


How Can the PRC Benefit You?

What is a Parent Resource Center?

The Parent Resource Center is funded by the Title I Program.

Our resource center is available to **all** Allgood parents, grandparents, guardians and teachers. It is a lending library designed to bridge the connection between school and home.



The Parent Resource Center Provides:

- Activities, instructional games, and practice materials to support reading and math skills.
- Brochures and pamphlets to help you support your child's education.
- Leveled books.
- A computer and printer for parent/guardian use.
- Instructional games and books in Spanish.
- Books and videos covering many parenting issues.

How Are Materials Checked Out & Returned?

- Parents are welcome to come in and sign out materials. We ask that you keep the items for a few weeks and then return them to school.
- Teachers may check out materials for students and send them home.
- Parents may request materials for a specific reading or math skill and the materials will be sent home with the student.
- When returning materials, parents may:
