GOALS

- INCREASE THE PERCENTAGE OF STUDENTS IN GRADES 3-5 ACHIEVING PROFICIENT AND DISTINGUISHED LEVELS ON THE MATH GEORGIA MILESTONES FROM 35% IN MAY 2025 TO 45% IN MAY 2026.

BELIEFS

DEMOGRAPHICS

DALLAS SERVES APPROXIMATELY 520 STUDENTS IN GRADES K-5. THE STUDENT POPULATION IS COMPRISED OF 54% BLACK/AFRICAN AMERICAN, 23% WHITE, 12% HISPANIC/LATINO AND 10% IDENTIFYING AS TWO OR MORE RACES. APPROXIMATELY 75% OF STUDENTS ARE ELIGIBLE FOR FREE OR REDUCED-PRICE LUNCH, INDICATING A SIGNIFICANT PERCENTAGE OF LOW-INCOME FAMILIES. 3% OF THE STUDENT BODY IS CLASSIFIED AS ENGLISH LANGUAGE LEARNERS (ELL), AND 17% RECEIVE SPECIAL EDUCATION SERVICES.
