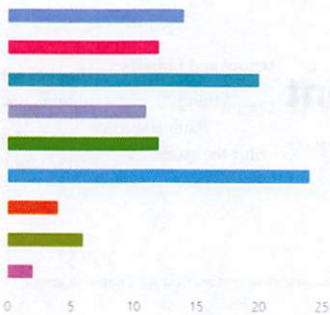

1. In what ways do you prefer to receive **communication** from your child's teacher and our school? Check all that applies.

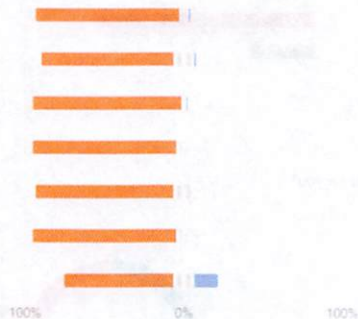

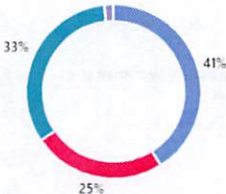

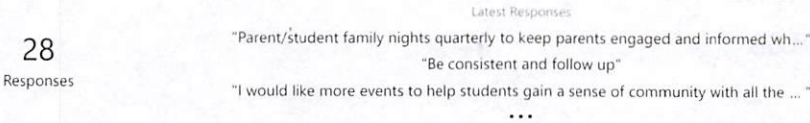

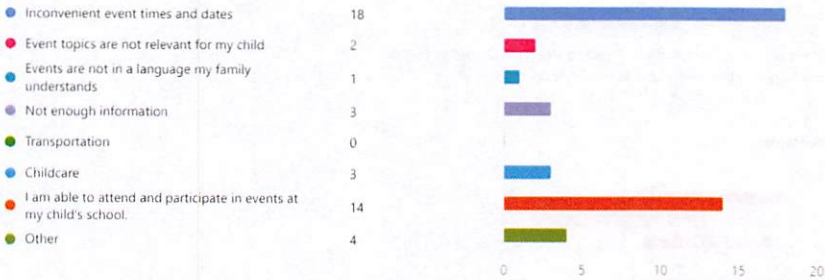
In what ways can the school help better support you and your family?

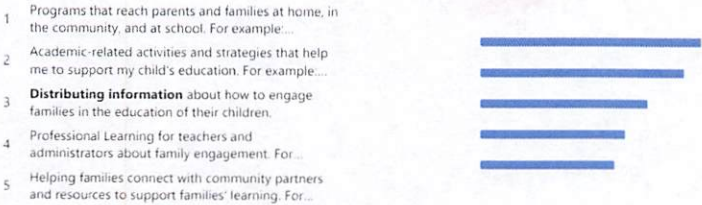
5. When you cannot participate in family engagement events, what are most likely the reasons you are unable to attend?



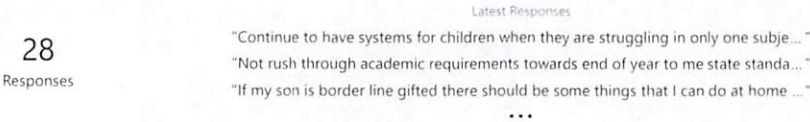
6. As we plan Family Engagement events, what time is most convenient for you?



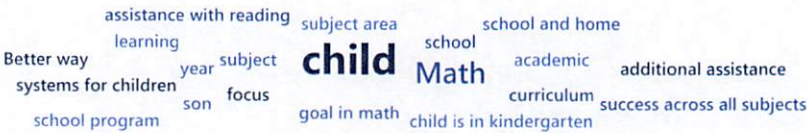
7. Our school receives **Title I federal funds** to support families and guardians with their child's education. With 1 being the highest, rank the following statements in order you believe we should spend the funds.
