The Parent Involvement Resource Center is funded by the Title I Program. Our resource center is available to all Hiram Elementary School parents, grandparents, guardians and teachers. It is a lending library designed to bridge the connection between school and home by assisting parents in providing ways to help their child with academics.

How Are Materials Checked Out & Returned?

- Parents are welcome to come to school on school days from 7:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. and sign out materials. We ask that items are returned within two weeks or when the item is finished being used.
- Teachers may check out materials for students to take home.
- Parents may request materials and items will be sent home with the student.

When returning materials, parents may:

- ⇒ send materials back to school with students
