Demographics

McGarity Elementary School serves approximately 532 students in grades Kindergarten through 5th. Our student population is diverse, with 16% identifying as Hispanic/Latino, 36% as Black/African American, 39% as White, 0.9% as Asian, and 8% identifying as two or more races. Nearly 60% of our students qualify for free or reduced-price lunch, highlighting the importance of addressing the needs of families. In addition, 7% of our students are English Language Learners, and 15% receive Special Education services. This diversity enriches our school community and underscores our commitment to equity, inclusion, and providing every child with the support needed to succeed academically and socially.
