November 1, 2018, Tallatoona will begin accepting appointments for the heating assistance program for <u>Senior Households</u> 65 & <u>Older and Homebound Households</u>. An appointment can be scheduled via the <u>website</u> or by <u>calling</u> the appointment line. <u>Homebound Households</u> can request a homebound appointment by calling the appointment line.

The <u>General Public</u> can schedule an appointment via the <u>website</u> or by <u>calling</u> the appointment line beginning <u>December 1</u>, <u>2018</u>.

Please bring the following documents to your heating assistance appointment:

- *Driver's license or state issued photo ID of the applicant and all household members 60 years of age and older
- *Original social security cards for EVERYONE living in the home
- *Proof of citizenship or immigration status; driver's license, US military ID, US passport or card, state issued photo ID, US permanent resident card, alien registration card, employment authorization document, certificate of citizenship are all acceptable documents as proof of citizenship
- *Most current **heating** bill (bill **MUST** be dated within 30 days)

GEORGIA LIHEAP

- *NEW REQUIREMENT If your home is heated with natural gas, kerosene, propane, or wood you MUST bring both your heating bill and electric bill to the appointment.
- *Proof of income for the last 30 days for <u>everyone</u> 18 years or older living in the home; income includes, but is not limited to, alimony, child support, disability, pension, rental income, retirement, social security, unemployment, wages from work, wages from self employment, and worker's compensation
- *If there is someone 18 or older living in the home who has zero income, they MUST come to the appointment
