Nebo is a Title I School

What is Title I?

Title I is a federally funded program for schools. Nebo receives funds which are used for educational services for children to provide additional support to ensure academic success.
The focus of the Title I program is on helping all students meet high standards.
At Nebo Elementary, our Title I program provides the following:

Teachers who work with students who can benefit from additional support

- Learning resources for students
- Professional learning resources for teachers
- Resources and activities for parents to access as they support their child academically.

Nebo Parent and Family Engagement Plan

Nebo Elementary's Parent Engagement Plan is a plan that outlines what we will provide for parents and guardians, and how we will provide opportunities to work together, to strengthen the academic success of each child in our school. This plan is developed annually with input from parents and school staff to meet the changing needs of parents and the school.

Our Parent Engagement Plan is updated every year. In early spring, a survey will be made available to all parents, and may be taken on-line or on a paper copy that is sent home to all families of our students. It is advertised through bulletins, phone calls, and in parent meetings. The survey asks for feedback on the current Parent Engagement Plan and parent engagement opportunities that took place during the school year and invites input in the development of the updated plan. Participation from parents is also sought through responses on feedback forms provided at all parent engagement meetings and other activities, the availability of a suggestion box, and meetings planned specifically for developing the plan together. Parents will also have the opportunity to provide input, through the survey and other opportunities, on how Title I funds allocated for parent engagement activities will be spent.

Once the Plan is created, it is presented to parents and school staff (in parent engagement meetings, through the school website, and accessibility to paper copies in the school) for final agreement; it is then introduced as the Parent Engagement Plan for the current school year at the Annual Title I Parent Involvement Meeting which takes place in early fall.

Nebo Elementary's Parent Engagement Plan is distributed to families of all students in our school and is available to the local community on our school website and in our Parent Resource Center. We always strive to make continual progress in working with our parents and welcome any feedback and suggestions throughout the school year.

PCSD Goals for 2021-2022 are to:

- During the 2021-2022 school year, PCSD will prepare students to increase the percent of students scoring proficient/advanced in Math, Science, ELA, and Social Studies by 3% on Georgia Milestones.
- During 2021-2022, PCSD will prepare students to increase the performance of subgroups (SED, EL, ED) in ELA by 3% on Georgia Milestones.
- During 2021-2022, PCSD will reduce the percentage of subgroups (SWD, EL, ED) assigned to OSS and ISS by 3% as reported in the student information system with subgroups.

Nebo Elementary 2021-2022 School Goals:

- Students in grades K-5 will increase proficient and advanced from 36% to 50% as measured by the Reading Inventory from August 2021 to May 2022.
- Students in grades K-5 will increase proficient and advanced from 19% to 50% as measured by the Math Inventory from August 2021 to May 2022.
- At least 85% of our students will respond to tiered intervention supports for behavior as evidenced by office discipline referrals and SWIS data analysis by receiving 1 referral or less during the 2021-2022 school year.
