Submit a personal video that is 2 minutes or less that answers BOTH of the questions below. This is your opportunity to be as creative as you would like. Factors to keep in mind: you MUST answer the two questions below and your video MUST be 2 minutes or less. Videos that exceed 2 minutes will be stopped at the 2-minute mark and the remaining video will not be viewed by the screening committee.
