Demographics

Northside Elementary offers a diverse learning community. The total school population includes about 650 students with the following demographic composition: 53% male; 47% female; 29.2% Black or African American; 7.3% two or more races; 13.8% Hispanic or Latino; and 48.7% White. About 16% of our students participate in special education, and 4.9% of our students are identified as English Language Learners.
