What is Title I?

For the 2025-2026 school year, Herschel Jones Middle School school year receives federal funds through the Title I Program to improve the academic achievement of students in meeting the state's high academic achievement standards. This program and these funds are used to provide the following:

- * Additional teachers to work with eligible students who can benefit from additional support.
- * Learning resources for participating students.
- * Professional learning resources for teachers supporting identified students.
- * Resources and activities for participating parents to access as they support their child academically.
- * Families and guardians of students are offered numerous opportunities to share how they would like to see funds best used to support student success.

What is it?

The Parent Engagement Plan outlines what we will provide for parents and guardians, and how we will provide opportunities to work together to strengthen the academic success of each child in our school. Our plan is based on school goals for student academic achievement and is developed with input from parents/guardians and school staff.

How is it revised?

The Parent & Family Engagement Plan is updated yearly, with input collected in the fall and winter. Parents can provide feedback through an online or paper survey, shared via bulletins, flyers, calls, meetings, and the Student/Family Resource Center. The survey will gather input on the plan and past engagement activities. Parents may also share feedback at meetings and family events.

Who is it for?

Herschel Jones Middle School has a Title I, school-wide program school. Families and students in this program are encouraged to participate in all opportunities outlined in the plan. The plan is written in clear language, with translations available upon request. We welcome feedback year-round as we work with families to make continual progress.

Where is it available?

Jones Middle Parent & Family Engagement Plan is distributed to parents and guardians of eligible students in our school, and is available on our school website, and in our Student/Family Resource Center. Translation of all information will be provided upon request.



2025-2026 District Goals

- By May, enhance the quality and effectiveness of professional learning initiatives to empower teachers in positively transforming their instructional practices, thereby directly impacting student achievement.
- By May, cultivate meaningful collaborative opportunities that foster strong relationships and active engagement between District staff, families, and communities, resulting in a positive impact on student achievement.
- Increase student performance in all core content areas by 3% annually as measured by achievement data.



2025-2026 School Goals

- By May 2025, we will increase the percentage of students scoring Level 3 or 4 on the ELA section of the Georgia Milestones assessment.
- By May 2025, we will increase the percentage of students scoring Level 3 or 4 on the Math section of the Georgia Milestones assessment.
- During the 2024-2025 school year, we will decrease the number of days students spend in ISS and OSS by 20%
