What is a Parent Resource Center?

The Parent Resource Center is funded by the Title I Program.

Our resource center is available to ALL Dobbins Middle School Targeted Assistance students, their family (parents, grandparents, guardians), and teachers. It is a lending library designed to bridge the connection between school and home.

The Parent Resource Center Provides:

- Activities, instructional games, and practice materials to support math
- Brochures and pamphlets to support your scholars education
- A Computer, printer, scanner, and laminator for parent/guardian/student use
- Spanish Dictionaries & Spanish Picture Dictionaries
- Materials for class and school projects (poster boards, paper, cardstock, binders, markers, yarn, etc.)
- Copies of Title I documents: Dobbins Middle School Improvement Plan, Dobbins Family Engagement Plan, Dobbins Family-School Compact, and Paulding county's District Parental Engagement Plan

How are Materials Checked Out & Returned?

- Parents are welcome to come in and sign out materials. We ask that you keep the items a few weeks and then return them to school.
- Teachers may check out materials for students and send them home.
- Parents may request materials for a specific math skill and the materials will be sent home with the student.

When returning materials, parents may:

- Drop off materials in the front office
- Send materials back with their student
