Purpose: To support student growth by providing structured opportunities to reflect, relearn, and demonstrate mastery after summative assessments

STEP 1:

POSTTEST REFLECTION

Complete a short reflection after each summative assessment.

Reflect on:

- What you understood
- What challenged you
- How you can grow from the experience

This will be used by teachers to guide support and planning.

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STEP 2:

PLAN FOR SUPPORT

Collaborate with your teacher to choose the best support:

- Reteaching sessions
- Extra practice tasks
- Small group help
- Study and preparation strategies

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STEP 3:

STAY ON TRACK

- Turn in the original summative assessment on time.
- Complete all formative work before summative assessments. Missing formative work may result in missing a retake, but you can still show growth on future assessments.

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RETESTING OPPORTUNITIES

- Up to 2 retests per semester.
- No minimum score required to retest.
- Full credit can be earned back based on new learning.
- Use retesting chances wisely.
