Principal's Corner

I hope your family enjoyed the holiday break and are already off to an amazing 2020! With so many extra-curricular activities at our school, we often forget to share academic news with our families. We are very proud of the progress students are making this year. Your children are growing in both reading and math!

We monitor students' reading and math achievement multiple times a year using the district provided Math Inventory (MI) and Reading Inventory (RI). The MI is measured in 'quantiles' and provides information on how well students are mastering the Georgia math standards. The RI is measured in 'Lexiles'. The RI measures growth a little differently. While there are grade level ranges, a student's score is based on reading levels across all grades (1st-12th).

In December, our students took the MI for the second time this year. In August, 19% of our students were either proficient or advanced in math. We're excited that at the mid-year point, 50% of our students scored either proficient or advanced in math!! This is tremendous growth with half of the year still ahead of us. We are excited about our end of the year prospects and are anxious to see if 100% of our students score proficient or advanced! During January, our students will continue to assess their knowledge on the RI. I look forward to sharing this data with you in February.

Other information I want to share with you is our enrollment and attendance. Since opening the doors to the new school year on August 1, we've enrolled 129 students. Another 83 students have withdrawn. This means there are many new faces around our building that are learning our expectations for participation and behavior. One of the areas in which we struggle is getting everyone to school on time each day. During the 1st semester, 179 students had more than 3 tardies. Of those, 40 students accumulated more than 10 tardies. Even arriving a few minutes late throws off your child's schedule and impacts their teacher's ability to get instruction started quickly each morning. Please help us by leaving home in plenty of time to arrive before 7:55AM. Students are officially tardy if they are not in their classrooms by 8:00AM.

I appreciate all you do to support our Allgood students and staff. We don't take lightly the amazing gift we've been given to work with children each day. Thank you for sharing yours with us!
