Principal's Corner

We've had a busy first month of school! We opened our doors on August 1 with 844 students. In one month, our student population has grown to 920! We are quickly approaching new enrollment records! With many families being new to Allgood, I wanted to share information about upcoming events in September: All Pro Dads, our annual Fun Run and Title 1 Curriculum Night.

Our All Pro Dads meetings occur every other month. Our first meeting is on September 13. We gather at 7:30AM in the gym. The program is developed by Tony Dungy, and includes a quick presentation, a continental breakfast, and opportunities for Dads to interact in fun ways with their children. Everyone is welcome to join us! We love having Dads, Granddads, and Uncles, but everyone is always welcome!

Something new we're doing this year is Title 1 Curriculum Night on September 12. During the evening, parents will have opportunities to talk with teacher teams about what students will be learning this year. This is an event that allows all students to participate in a full day of science exploration.

Time for Learning!


