AdvancED will visit the PCSD October 7-10 to review the school districts' accreditation. Accreditation is a voluntary method of quality assurance designed to distinguish schools adhering to a set of educational standards. To retain accreditation, a district must meet AdvancED Standards, demonstrate high levels of student performance, and provide evidence of stakeholder satisfaction with the operation of the district.
