Literacy

One of the strategies in our SIP is the Bookworms reading framework that consists of three components. One of the components is the differentiated instructional block or DI. Through this segment, easily gathered data guide teachers in the formation of small, temporary groups for targeted instruction. Ultimately, students progress up a carefully sequenced staircase of increasingly sophisticated skills to build their literacy.
