As part of the PCSD community, you know that our district takes safety very seriously and employs a wide range of tools, personnel, training, technology and other resources to help ensure our schools remain safe learning environments.



We have now added another tool to make reporting safety issues even simpler. PCSD is now using *SafeSchools Alert*, a tip reporting service that allows students, staff, and parents to submit safety concerns to our administration five different ways:

You and your child can easily report tips on bullying, harassment, drugs, vandalism, threats of violence, or any safety issue you're concerned about through SafeSchools Alert. When you submit a tip, be sure to use our district's identification code: **1895** in your communication.

Every tip SafeSchools Alert receives about our district is **immediately logged in the system** and our administration is notified so that they can investigate and take appropriate action.
