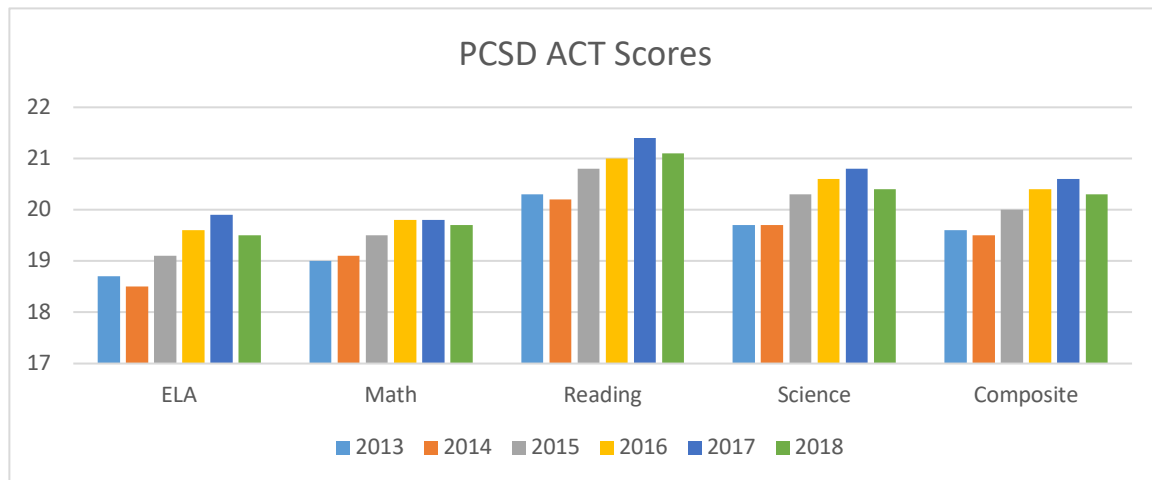




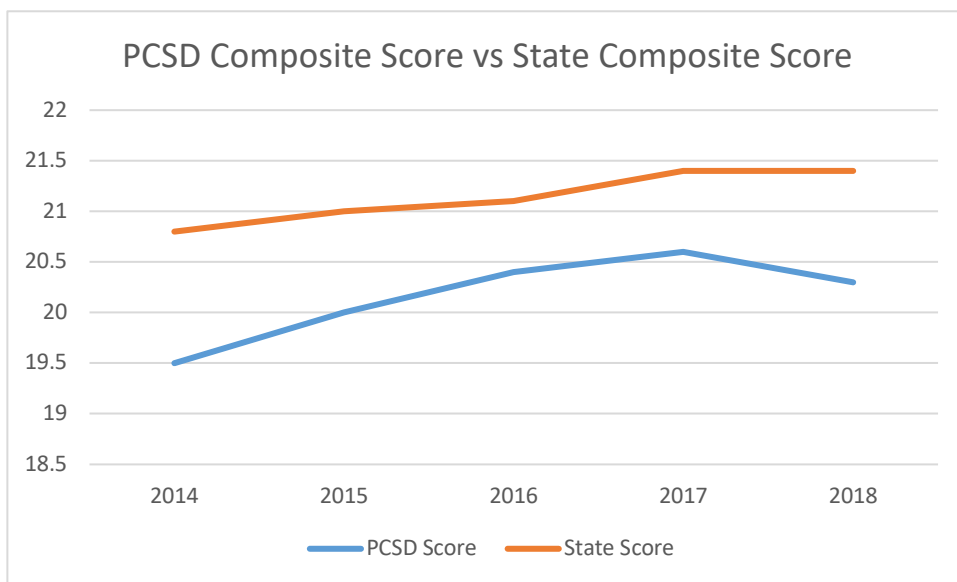
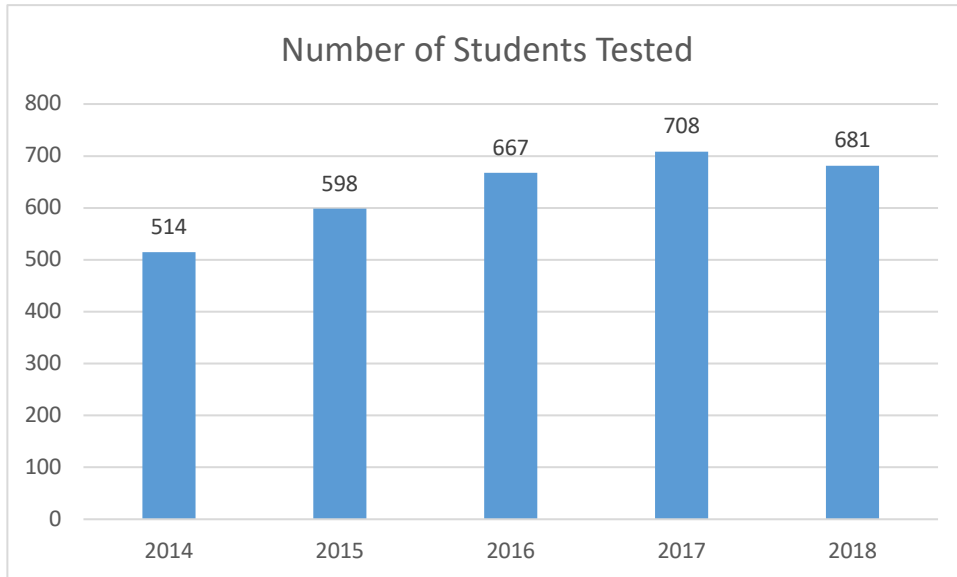
Summary Brief

ACT 2018

The ACT examination assesses high school students' general educational development and their ability to complete college level work. All colleges and universities in Georgia accept scores from the ACT for admission purposes. ACT is administered at different times throughout the year. The charts below identify the average composite ACT score in English, Math, Reading and Science, the number of students tested and the district and state comparison for the last five years.

District Summary Findings

- The number of students tested has increased within the county over the past five years from 514 to 681.
- The PCSD average composite scores has increased overall from a 19.6 in 2013 to a 20.3 in 2018.
- While the State continues to outperform us on the ACT, we have decreased the gap between the state average and the PCSD average.
