HISTORY & BACKGROUND

- Home of the Titans est. 2001
- The school sits on 42 acres
- After addition completion the school is 124,070 square feet with 65 instructional units
- The original capacity was 675; the new capacity is 1,050 FTE (students) per DoE Standards
- The project included an addition to assist Moses in meeting expected growth projections in the next 10 years. In addition it allows for space for housing district programs.

DESCRIPTION

- New, free-standing classroom addition of 25,149 square feet
- Addition features 20 instructional units
- Support areas including administrative office, workroom, storage spaces, and restrooms.
- Uplift to the front face of the school with new crosswalk, redesigned front parking, and additional parking lot
- Asphalt repair and resurfacing for campus
- Clinic relocated and remodeled to better serve students and access to parents
- Main facility and addition tied into public sewer transitioning from septic

TIMELINE

- Project was completed June 2021
- Student occupancy August 2021
- Total construction timeline June 2020-June 2021



SAFETY & SECURITY

- An enclosed walkway connects the new addition to the existing school building
- A raised crossway to the additional parking for pedestrian safety
- Designed to remain as a standalone single building
- Fire alarm and life safety systems were included in the addition and updated in existing facility to comply with local codes and ordinances
- Additional access control installed
- Alertus emergency communication installed
