

V. The "Reporting" Tab: Tracking Student Progress

Teachers are able to track student progress on assignments and by standards. View reports by selecting "Reporting" from the top toolbar.

(1) Assessment Reporting:

- a. Data can be filtered by assessment and standard
- b. <u>By Assessment:</u>
 - i. Filter by grade, discipline, class name, student(s), and the percentage scored
 - ii. By selecting "View" next to the lesson/ assessment title, you can see which specific questions each student got right or wrong
