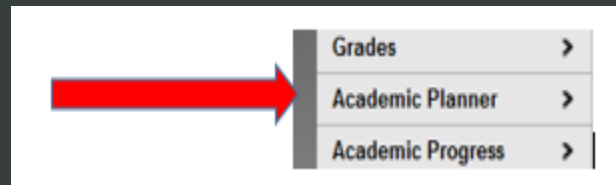
IGP = PLANNING AND TRACKING A PERSONAL PATHWAY TO GRADUATION



# What is MYAP?



- The Multi-Year Academic Planning tool (MYAP) is a process that helps students develop an academic path for their entire high school career.
- This tool is the method used for the student update his/her Individual Graduation Program (IGP).



# MYAP Graduation Programs are designed to ensure students:

- Earn Minimum Credit Requirements to Graduate from High School
- Plan to Take Rigorous Courses
- Pass Courses
- Take Advantage of Pathway Courses
- Monitor the GPA (Grade Point Average)
- Consider and/or Take Advantage of Move on When Ready Course Opportunities

# At the end of the journey, students:

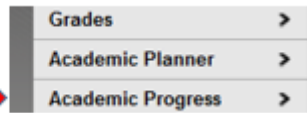
- Graduate from high school
- Complete one or more pathways in:
  - CTAE
  - Fine Arts
  - World Language
  - Academic Area
- Earn both high school credits and college hours by participating in the MOWR Program
  - May earn an Associates Degree
  - May earn a certificate or diploma from a Technical College

# How does MYAP work?

- Students are initially assigned one of four IGP programs. The initial graduation program is the CTAE program.
- Then, a student stays with that program or selects a graduation program with an emphasis in Fine Arts or World Language.
- A student who does not have a concentration in CTAE, Fine Arts or World Language may select the standard IGP.
- Students and parents can view and track progress under Academic Progress on the left menu of the IC Portal.
- Students and parents may toggle back and forth between any of the graduation programs which are:
  - IGP CTAE
  - IGP Fine Arts
  - IGP World Language
  - IGP

# Academic Progress

- It is easy to track Academic Progress during the high school years by going to Academic Progress in the portal and clicking on that option. Students and parents view this information:

# Students select courses on the plan during the time that the portal is open.

- Course registration is available for the next school year with the exception of the core courses. Teachers recommend core courses only for the next school year.
- Course registration is available for review and edit for the following Credit Types for the next school year:
  - CTAE
  - Fine Arts
  - World Language
  - Elective
- For each future school year beyond the next school year the student plans all courses.
- All courses = 8 full credit courses per academic year.
- As new courses become available these courses will appear in a drop down list for the student and parent.

# Once the IGP is locked for the remainder of the school year...

- Planned courses become the course requests for the next school year.
- These course requests become the schedule of courses.
- Any changes to the course requests for the next school year must go through the student's counselor during the window of time that the portal is closed.



# When did the use of the MYAP tool begin?

- Use of the tool began in February 2017.
- Portal is open to students and parents during March and the portal closes by the schedule of each of the five high schools.
