What are our School Improvement Goals?

Goal #1: Increase the percentage of 1st—5th grade students scoring proficient and advanced on the Math Inventory from 13% in August 2021 to 70% in May 2022.

Goal #2: Increase the percentage of 3rd, 4th, and 5th grade students scoring proficient and advanced as measured by the Reading inventory from 43% in August 2021 to 80% in May 2022.

Goal #3: Increase the percentage of students scoring proficient or above on the narrative writing response on the 2021-2022 Georgia Milestones Assessment (4th and 5th grade from 24% in 2020-2021 to 50% in 2021-2022).

We are so excited for our 3rd-5th grade students to show everyone how much they have learned since Kindergarten.
