


PURPOSE OF CONFERENCES

 - Review progress




The Rational

- Parents are a primary resource of information about children for teachers




We Know That:

 Children receive the best education when parents and teachers work together to build learning opportunities




Keep in Mind..

- No one knows your child better than you do
- No one has a greater influence on your child than you do
- Teachers are seeking your help with your child's education




Everyone Learns In Different Ways

- Some learn by hearing, some by seeing, some by doing
- Most learn in a combination
- Share with your teacher what you have observed about your child's learning




Getting Ready..

- Think about what you'd like to know, and make some notes to take with you
- If there's anything you believe is important for the teacher to know about your child's life at home, make note of it




Getting Ready..

- Note any concerns you may have about your child's learning
- Talk to your child ~ is there anything he/she wants you to discuss at the conference?
- Find out how you child thinks he/she is doing




Getting Ready..

- Ask you child about what subjects they feel that are having trouble in and which ones are their best ones
- Reassure your child about the conference, that it's a meeting to help them




At the Conference..

- Remember that you and the teacher are working together for one purpose: to help your child learn and do well in school
- Be specific: refer to your notes as often as you need to




During the Conference..

- Ask questions!
 - Is my child in different groups for different subjects? Why?
 - How well does my child get along with others?
 - What are my child's best and worst subjects?
 - Is my child working up to his or her ability?
 - Does my child participate in class?



After the Conference..

- Share what you learned with your child
- Set new goals and make plans on how they will be achieved
- Praise your child for all the good!
