





Math: Adding and subtracting

ELA: Reading books about George Washington and Abraham Lincoln

Letter of the Week: Vv

Writing: We Will be writing about How To do make something as well as writing about George Washington and Abraham Lincoln. The students are working on spacing when writing a sentence, using a capital letter at the beginning of the sentence and ending with a period.
