This Week's Focus

Our school year is broken up into nine week sections. During the first nine weeks of school your child will be working on the following skills.

Math: Comparing numbers and teen numbers

ELA: Reading books about Pumpkins, Thanksgiving and Five senses.

Phonics: We will work daily on all letters and all sounds. We will have a focus letter each week.

Letter of the Week: Rr

Writing: The students are working on drawing to show meaning. They are also learning to separate words by leaving a space when writing a sentence, that a sentence is a group of words and to put a period at the end of their sentence. We will be writing about Pumpkins and Thanksgiving for the next few weeks.

Science/Social Studies: Pumpkins, 5 Senses, and Thanksgiving
