Reading

We will continue to work on identifying story elements. These elements include. identifying characters, the setting, and plot. Students will retell the plot using illustrations. We will be focusing on reviewing what setting means. We will study this concept by reading a variety of texts.

We will begin to read The Wizard of Oz to help with many of our standards.

R2: Identifies key details; retells stories

R3: describes story elements using key details

Language Arts

Phonics will continue this week with the letters F, H, G, and R.

We will continue to use the writing process as we write about our small moments. We will be looking at ways to make our writing better (revising).

Math

What a great job our students have been doing on counting to 120! This is still a standard we will be working on, and we will also be working with understanding addition. subtraction, and the equal sign! We will be doing a great deal of assessing to make sure we are targeting the correct skills for our students.

NBT1: extends the counting sequence. Counts, reads, writes, and represents numbers up to 120.

OA5: Relate counting to addition and subtraction

MD4: Represents and interprets data up to three categories

S.S./Science

We will be finishing our unit on maps and globes for this nine weeks. We will begin to study weather. In particular, the seasons, different types of weather and weather instruments.

S1E1: Earth Science. Weather.

School - to -Home Connection

Math: Using two groups of like items, grab chunks of each. Have your child determine the total and then give you the addition problem that matches. For example, grab 6 skittles and 3 grapes. There are 9 in all and the addition problem is 6 + 3 = 9

Reading: As your child reads, stop every so often to see if she understands what is happening in the book. Ask her what she thinks might happen next.

Phonics: Practice some alliteration by making some silly sentences. Alliteration is the repetition of consonant sounds at the beginning of words. An example would be: Dolphins dive deep down in the sea.
