Differentiated Instruction:

This year we have begun a schoolwide literacy initiative that mirrors county expectation. For 45 minutes each day, students are receiving explicit reading instruction based on their current level of functioning and needs. This is referred to as our NBI/DI block. During this critical time, students are exposed to text at and above their current reading level in efforts to raise their Lexile level, increase fluency and vocabulary as will as assist in reading comprehension.

Math Workshop: We are continuing to teach math through the workshop model. This simply means the lesson takes place in three parts: opening, worktime and closing. Teachers model expectations, allow students time to work independently or in groups and then students lead the closing sharing how they solved mathematical problems. During the closing students show their understanding through their ability to explain their thought processes
