Dear Parents/Guardians of In-Person Instruction Students at Paulding County High School:

This letter is to confirm our previous communication that following Thanksgiving Break we will transition toward more in-person instruction.

➤ **Beginning Monday November 30:**

- **In-person instruction will take place four days per week – Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday.**
- **Fridays will continue to be Digital Learning Days.**

This transition is conditioned on our continued monitoring of confirmed COVID-19 cases in our school community. To keep our high schools as healthy as possible, we want to emphasize important practices to prevent the spread of COVID-19. These include frequent hand washing, social distancing when feasible, and wearing face coverings (masks and shields). Wearing a mask is a simple way to keep both you and your school community healthy. All of these practices are strongly encouraged.
