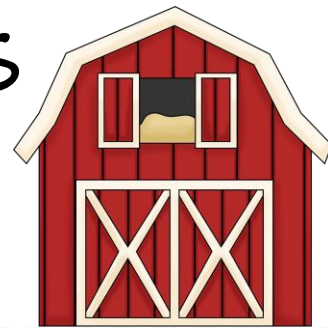
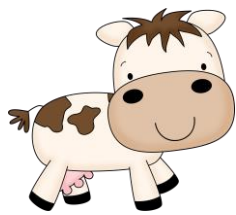


First Grade News
