## **Proceedings:**

 $\cdot$  *Meeting called to order* at 6:03 p.m. by School Principal, Ronnetta Simpson. Welcome back and Recap on Meeting Roles/Training from previous year.

What is Local School Council? - PowerPoint is available on EPHS website. The PowerPoint will be updated as new information becomes available. Meeting notices for EPHS School Council meetings are required to be posted 72 hours in advanced.

EPHS updates: EPHS graduation rate is up! Graduation Rate increased to 88.7% from 87.1% in 2018. Successful strategies that allowed this goal to be accomplished included: Common Instruction Focus, School Wide Professional Learning, and Literary Strategies.

The previous year the focus was on Reciprocal teaching. When the data was studied, we saw a need to incorporate literacy across the curriculum with RECSET reading strategy. Literacy will look different in each subject. Mr. Curtis spoke to how this reading strategy is used within the curriculum.

CCRPI results are in and EPHS scored 77.8, increasing 6.7 points from 2018 71.1. CCRPI scores are calculated with 4 diverse levels along with points broken down by subgroups such as: socio economic status, race, growth, attendance, ESEP/Gifted, etc. We are excited about the progress made and will work to continue progress. EPHS's Data Team is continuing to monitor the Pass/Fail rates. The Data Team is looking at a multifaceted approach to targeting the area where to improve student achievement. For students that are not on track, standard remediation is available. The monitoring of Pass/Fail rate started on the 2<sup>nd</sup> week of school this year.

This year at EPHS: ICLE has been an amazing journey. May speak at ICLE to share ESEP experience. SMART Goals for 2019-2020 have been set and in line to increasing CCRPI scores. Teachers are training monthly to be a lead in PLC's. The Professional Learning Model is in place. Professional Learning is differentiated by departments. The PLC playbook for step by step instruction is in place. The Writing strategy calendar is complete.

EPHS is incorporating Social Emotional/Learning: Capturing Kids Hearts (20 teachers trained) PBIS (Positive Behavior in School) and Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI): Upward Bound, Shared Leadership, and Tutoring just to name a few school wide.
