



This list is only a suggested list of supplies to help you get organized and study more effectively. It is highly recommended for students to use a backpack to hold their materials.

- ☐ *CLEAR Refillable water bottle labeled with student name*
- ☐ *Marbled composition notebooks (not spiral notebooks)– **4 per semester (1 for each subject – 8 total for year)***
- ☐ *One 3” Binder or Two 2” Binders*
- ☐ *Dividers w/ Pockets*
- ☐ *Calculator: Scientific Calculator i.e. TI-30x, etc. (also used in 8th Grade)*
- ☐ *Pencils and/or Mechanical Pencils*
- ☐ *Covered pencil sharpeners*
- ☐ *Erasers and/or Pencil Top Erasers*
- ☐ *Pencil Pouch or Pencil Box*
- ☐ *Pens: black, blue, and red*
- ☐ *Filler notebook paper (Loose Leaf Paper – college or wide ruled)*
- ☐ *Glue Sticks (8 total for the year)*
- ☐ *Colored Pencils*
- ☐ *Index Cards (2 packs for the year)*
- ☐ *Highlighters*
- ☐ *Crayons*
- ☐ *Blunt-tip scissors*
- ☐ *Ruler*
- ☐ *Mini stapler*
- ☐ *3-hole punch for notebook*
- ☐ *Earbuds (corded for use with a computer – these can be the inexpensive ones from a dollar store)*
