P. B. Ritch Supply List

This list is only a suggested list of supplies to help you get organized and study more effectively. It is highly recommended for students to use a backpack to hold their materials.

Daily Supplies:

- ☐ *CLEAR Refillable water bottle labeled with student name*
- ☐ *Marbled composition notebooks (not spiral notebooks) – 4 per nine weeks (1 for each subject – 16 total for year)*
- ☐ *One 3" Binder or Two 1" Binders or a 3-prong poly folder for each class (choose different colors)*
- ☐ *Calculator
 - *8th grade needs a scientific calculator i.e. TI-30x, etc.**
- ☐ *Dividers w/pockets*
- ☐ *Pencils and covered pencil sharpener (preferably no mechanical pencils)*
- ☐ *Pencil Pouch or Pencil Box*
- ☐ *Pens: black, blue, and red*
- ☐ *Filler notebook paper*
- ☐ *Ruler*
- ☐ *3-hole punch*
- ☐ *Mini stapler*
- ☐ *Earbuds (corded for use with a computer – these can be the inexpensive ones from a dollar store)*

Supplies to be kept in Pencil Pouch or Pencil Box for use in all classes on a weekly basis:

- ☐ *Erasers*
- ☐ *2 Glue Sticks*
- ☐ *Colored Pencils*
- ☐ *Index Cards*
- ☐ *Crayons*
- ☐ *Highlighters*
- ☐ *Blunt-tip scissors*

Recommended, but not required: Work with your child to establish an email account they can use that is appropriate without providing personal information, such as their name and birthdate. We suggest helping students to think long-term by asking how the email username would look if it were to appear on a resume? It is also strongly recommended that, as a parent, you maintain the login/password for the account so that you have it for monitoring purposes because this can be an email account they have for years to come.
