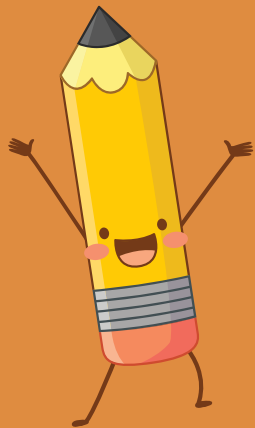


Welcome to 2nd Grade

Behavior Policy & Procedures

We are excited to share that Baggett Elementary is launching a new PBIS (Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports) incentive program this year to encourage positive behavior, responsibility, and teamwork. Our new system focuses on both individual and classroom rewards to keep students motivated and engaged.

Bear Bucks – Individual Incentive

- Every student will start the day with 5 Bear Bucks.
- Bear Bucks will only be taken after a verbal warning and if the misbehavior or lack of effort continues.
- Students can earn an extra Bear Buck each day for going above and beyond expectations!
- Specials and support staff may remove a Bear Buck if necessary, but they will always notify the classroom teacher.

Tracking Bear Bucks:

- Please see your child's daily behavior calendar to see how many Bear Bucks your child has earned each day!

Bear Paws – Class Incentive

- Classes can earn Bear Paws for showing excellent behavior in the cafeteria.
- Every two weeks, the class with the most Bear Paws will spin the Rewards Wheel for fun classroom prizes and activities.

PBIS Rewards Day

- Each nine weeks, students will get to spend their Bear Bucks on exciting activities during PBIS Rewards Day!

This new PBIS system is designed to celebrate students for making great choices every day while helping them learn accountability and teamwork. Thank you for supporting us as we work together to make Baggett Elementary a positive and encouraging place to learn and grow.

What is UFLI & Reading DI?

Differentiated Reading Instruction

The UFLI Foundations program is a structured literacy program designed to build strong reading skills in young learners, specifically focusing on decoding and word recognition. It's a systematic and explicit approach that helps students understand the relationship between sounds and letters, and how to blend those sounds to read and spell words. Parents can support their child's learning through UFLI by utilizing provided home practice materials and engaging in activities that reinforce these foundational skills. More information to come!

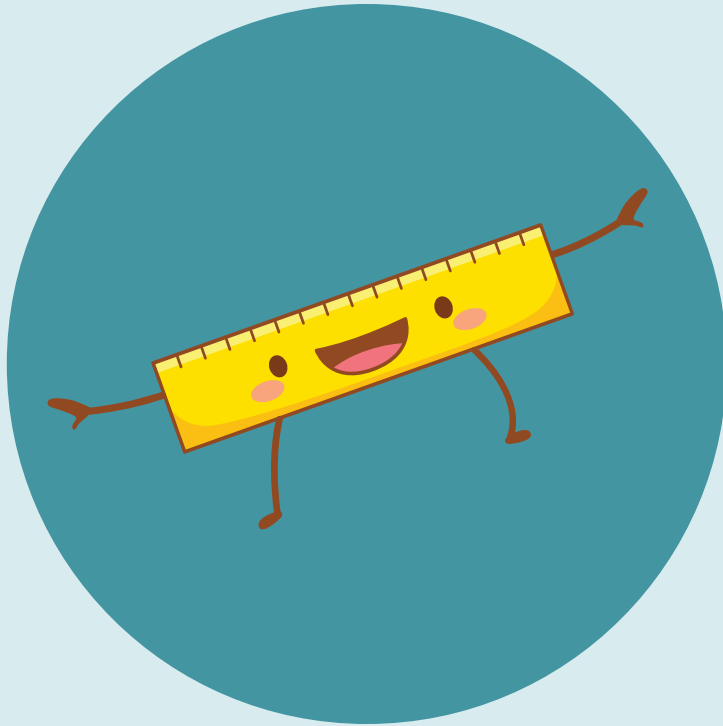

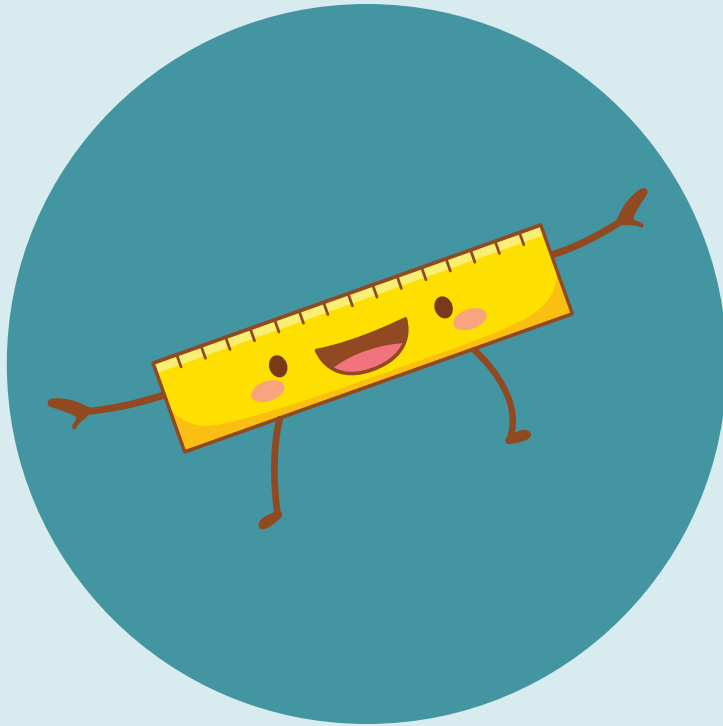

Access to Grades & End of Year Goals...

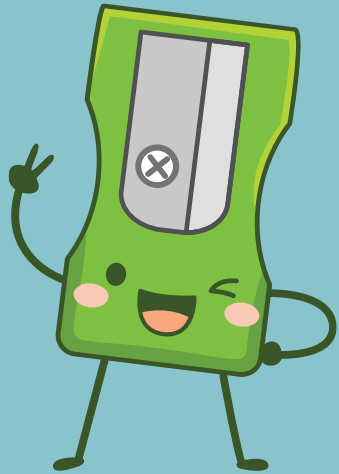
End of Year Goals...

- Reading Requirements – must meet 7 out of 9 expectations
- Writing Requirements – must meet 6 out of 8 expectations
- Science Requirements – must meet 3 out of 5 expectations
- Social Studies Requirements – must meet 3 out of 5 expectations
- Math Requirements – must meet 5 out of 7 expectations
- Fluency – 87+ wcpm end of year goal
