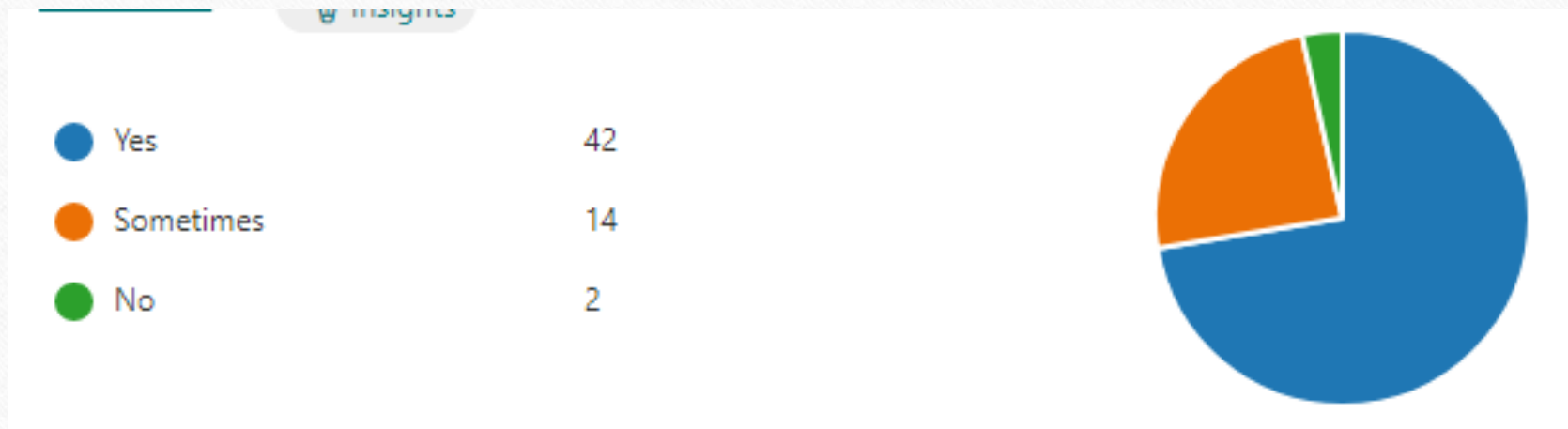

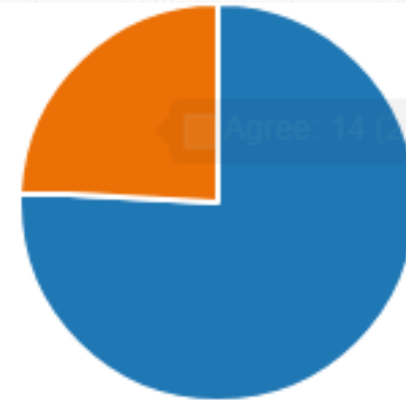

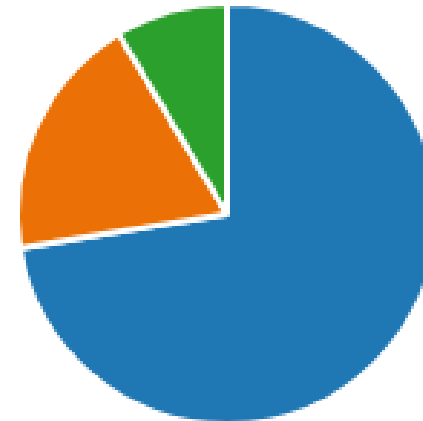

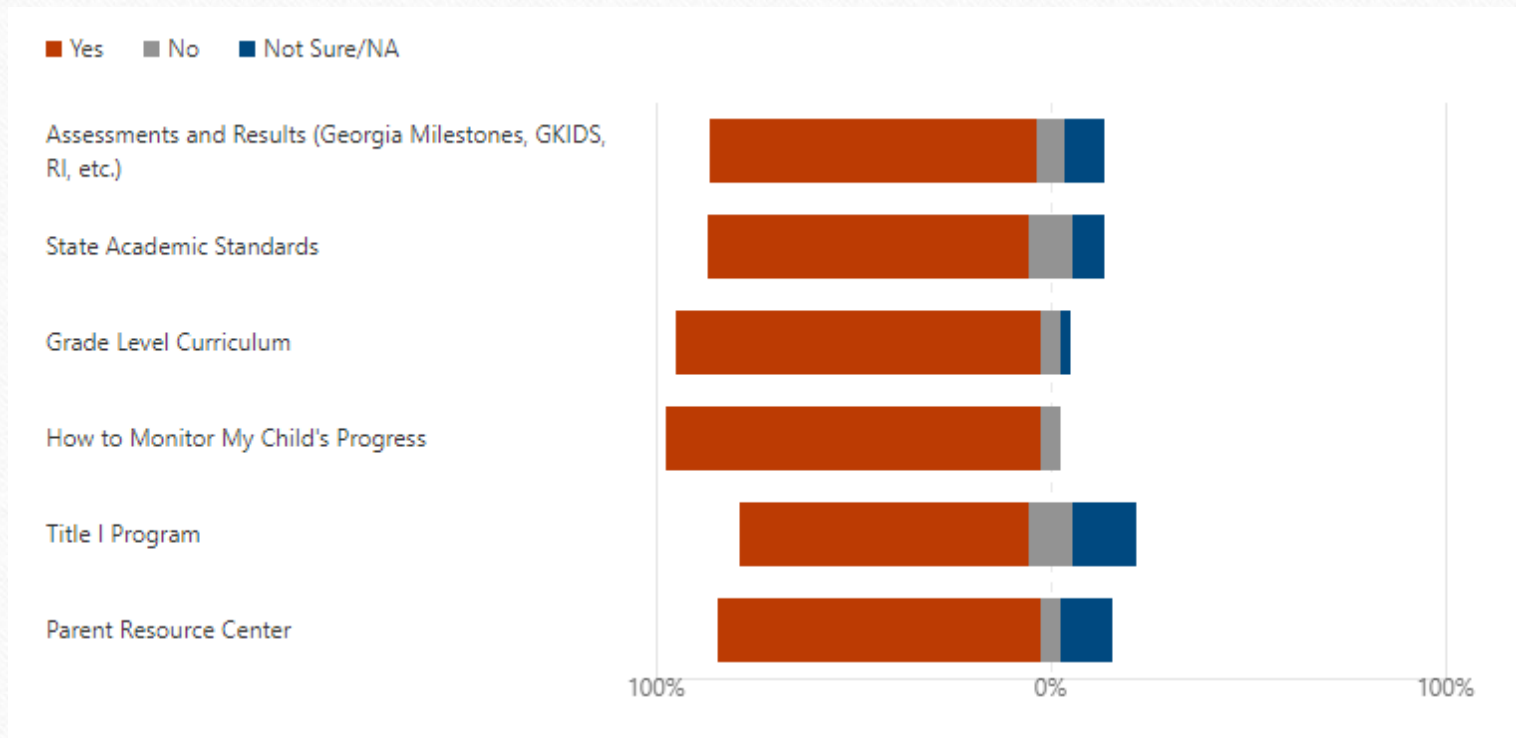


How well does your child's school provide information in a parent-friendly language?

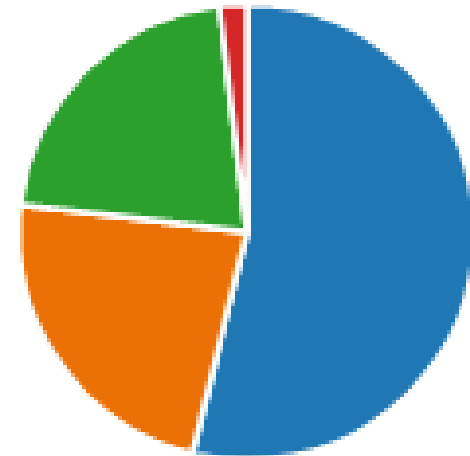


Have you been provided information or explanation(s) of the following topics?

How much does the school value the diversity of your child's background? (5 Stars- Highest Value)

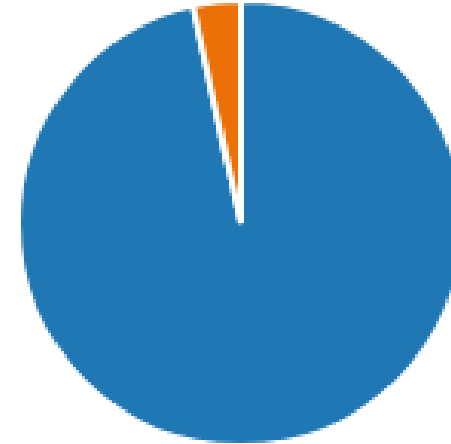

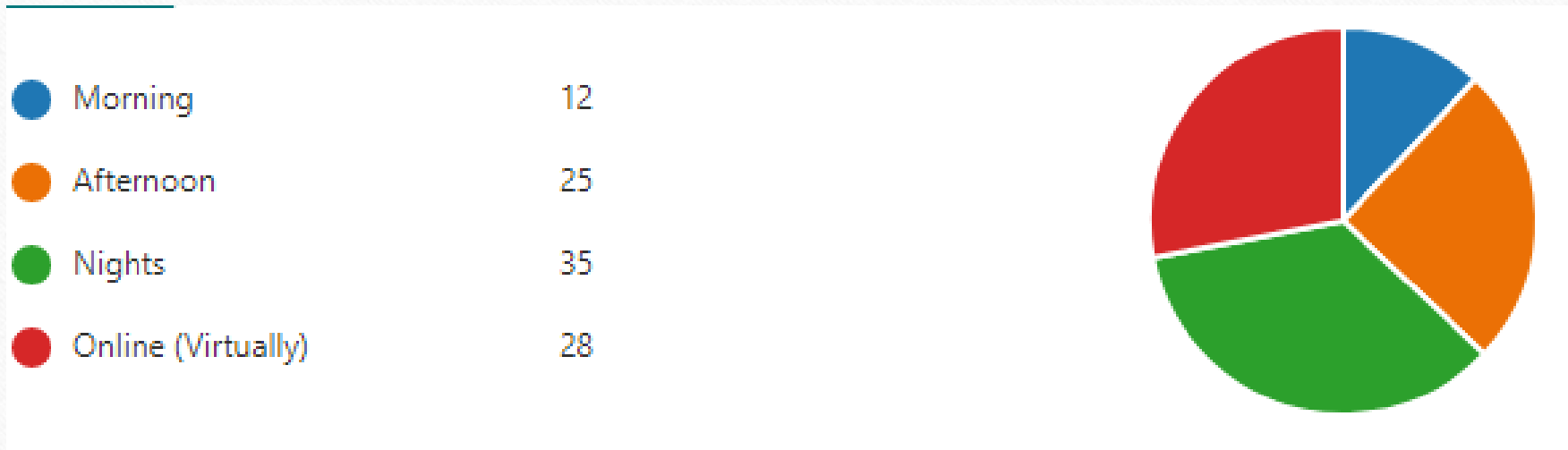

Does your child's school make the School-Parent Compact and district and school Family Engagement Plans available to you in multiple ways (school website, social media, flyers, etc.)?

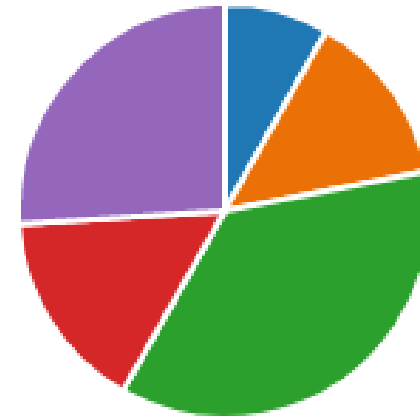


What is the best time for you to attend school events for parents and families? (Check all that apply.)
