<p>Game Day Activities</p>	<p>Gym</p> 	<p>6:00-6:30 7:00- 8:00</p>	<p>Hands on activities and active games are a great way to engage your child in reading and other important skills. Family game nights are a great way for everyone to get involved.</p>

<p>Write Your Own Play Book</p>	<p>Art Room</p> 	<p>6:00-6:30 7:00- 8:00</p>	<p>Have your child retell a story they have read. First with pictures and then add words and sentences. Fold pieces of paper in half and staple them to make a book. Ask your child to write sentences on each page and add his or her own illustrations.</p>
