SUCCESS



- Students should be able to read all 200 high frequency words by the end of first grade.
- Please remember that high frequency words are to be read within three seconds. Students should not be sounding out words, they should be read with automaticity.

HIGH FREQUENCY WORDS

Grade Level Goal -

Know all 200 sight words and read on grade level at 60 words correct per minute with a minimum 88% accuracy.

- > Focus on five to ten sight words each night with your student.
 - > Set a timer for your students to see if they can "beat the timer".
 - Create flashcards of the high frequency words your students do not know.
 - ▶ BAM! (Make and Take)
