

evidence of learning.

# 5<sup>TH</sup> GRADE THRESHOLDS

- Students must meet requirements for 4 out of 5 subject areas in order to pass  $5^{th}$  grade.

For Math and Reading: 14 out of 20 standards met

For Science: 5 out of 8 standards met

For Social Studies: 7 out of 10 standards met

For ELA/Writing: 7 out of 10 standards met

- Meeting the standard requires a score of 3 or 4.
