All Paulding County Schools will reopen for in-person learning on Monday, January 25. Thank you again for your willingness to adapt in this uncertain time. I also want to thank our teachers and school staffs who did an excellent job of seamlessly shifting to Digital Learning this week and continued to provide essential instruction for our students.

As a District, we will continue to make adjustments (temporarily close classes, schools or the District) as needed throughout the remainder of the school year.
