Dan Nolan Named Chairman of Paulding BOE, Deborah Collett Vice Chair, for 2022

In unanimous votes at its regular meeting Jan. 11, 2022, the Paulding County Board of Education named a new chairman and vice chair for 2022.

Dan Nolan, who represents District 6 in northeast Paulding County, was named the board's new chairman. Deborah Collett, who represents District 4 in south Paulding County, was named vice chair.

Mr. Nolan replaces Jeff Fuller who served three years as school board chairman. Mr. Nolan will oversee a school board that governs the 12th largest school district in Georgia with 33 schools and more than 30,000 students. The diverse district has more than 3,600 employees and an annual budget of more than \$313 million.

"I appreciate the Board's confidence in me to serve as chairman," said Mr. Nolan. "I am proud to be both a parent and school board member in this outstanding school system, and I thoroughly enjoy working with a school board that is committed to improving the educational experience for all Paulding County students. We are a growing district, and while there will certainly be challenges ahead, I look forward to getting to work."
