Dear East Paulding High School In-Person Instruction Parents/Guardians:

Due to continued monitoring of confirmed cases of COVID-19 in our school community, we are modifying our timeline for the transition to a hybrid schedule. As noted in our letter earlier this week, the original plan was to begin the hybrid schedule on Sept. 9th, but that plan has changed. Here is the new timeline:

- > Tuesday (9/8) through Friday (9/11) will be Digital Learning Days and there will be no in-person instruction. All EPHS students will learn online remotely.
- > Beginning Monday (9/14) in-person instruction at EPHS will move to a hybrid schedule that combines in-person instruction with Digital Learning.

Here is how the hybrid schedule will work:

If student last name begins A-K, you are: Group AK
If student last name begins L-Z, you are: Group LZ
