Dear High School Parents/Guardians of In-Person Instruction Students:

Throughout this unique school year, the changing COVID-19 environment has required that we remain flexible and ready to adjust as circumstances merit. As you may be aware, recently we have seen a rising number of new positive cases of COVID-19 throughout our community, and this spread is impacting our school operations. We are committed to providing in-person instruction as long as it is safe and operationally viable, and we work closely with the Department of Public Health (DPH) to help with those determinations.

**PCSD high schools will be open on Wednesday, Dec. 16, and Thursday, Dec. 17, so that students may take final exams. Wednesday, Dec. 16 will be a full school day, the Thursday, Dec. 17 school day will end at 12 p.m., and Friday, Dec. 18 will be a Digital Learning Day. All athletic events will continue as previously scheduled.**

<b>WEDNESDAY, DEC. 16</b> (Normal school hours)	Final exams will be given. The full school day schedule will take place.
<b>THURSDAY, DEC. 17</b> (Buses run at 12 p.m.)	Final exams will be given. The school day will end at 12 p.m. Students unable to take final exams Wednesday or Thursday for any reason <b>MUST</b> notify their teachers immediately. These students may have an opportunity to take the exam when we return from break in January.
<b>FRIDAY, DEC. 18</b>	Digital Learning Day.
	Students should check Canvas for class assignments beginning at 9 a.m. (See <i>ATTACHMENT A</i> ).

Thank you for continuing to be flexible as we adapt our plans to ensure the safest and healthiest possible learning environment. I apologize for any inconvenience this schedule change may cause, but I believe it will help ensure that all of our families enjoy a safe and healthy Holiday Break.

## Digital Learning Days Parent Information



### OVERVIEW

For future school closures, we may declare “Digital Learning Days”. If a digital learning day is declared, our students will have the opportunity to continue their learning while allowing flexibility to complete the activities at home. Teachers will provide assignments via Canvas, our learning management system, for students to complete at home. Teachers will also be available for virtual “office hours” through Canvas should students or parents have questions on the material or need assistance with their learning. The following are expectations for short term digital learning (1-2 days).

### DAILY ASSIGNMENT EXPECTATIONS

#### Kindergarten-2<sup>nd</sup> Grade

A Reading assignment and a Math Assignment with Science and Social Studies integrated

#### 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> Grade

One assignment in each of the following: Math and ELA with Science and Socials Studies integrated and specials (see schedule)

#### 6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> Grade

One assignment in each of their classes

#### 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> Grade

One assignment in each of their classes

### REQUIREMENTS

- All Digital Work will be housed in Canvas in a module labeled “DATE Digital Learning Day”.
- The module will be published for student access by 9:00 am on the Digital Learning Day.
- Each subject’s work will have a submission component such as quiz, discussion, or assignment.

### DIGITAL ACCESS CONCERNS

- Request a hard copy of assignments upon return to school
- Students will have time upon returning to school to complete assignments.
- Media Centers will be open before and after school as needed following a closure to provide students access to computers.
