They will be given opportunities to participate in Dual Enrollment, through several post-secondary partners, and gain career knowledge through Work-Based Learning/ Apprenticeship programs in local businesses. Through these experiences, students will acquire the skills, experience and connections needed to successfully transition directly into either a post-secondary or career environment.

PCCA will give students the opportunity to develop skills and earn college credits and credentials that will be essential to meet the needs of business and industry in our community and prepare them for careers that they can begin immediately upon graduation or use to get a head start on a college degree.

PCCA will open at the beginning of the 2019-2020 school year and serve students from grades 9-12 from all five high schools in Paulding County.

Healthcare CNA/Patient Care Tech



Transportation will be provided from a student's home
