



- Remain at home in Digital Learning with online instruction similar to Spring 2020 (21%)
- Enroll in a Virtual Academy where instruction is completed independently (3%)
- Other option (4%)

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- 3 Supply lists, dates for events, and communication from school/teacher about preparing to return


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- 4 Counselor support or social emotional programs to help adjust back to full-time school




# Supports Students Need When Return to School

- Most comments were positive regarding wanting students to return to school
