The SPHS Academy of Engineering & Technology will prepare students for careers in high demand career fields including:



AERONAUTICAL ENGINEERING

Aeronautical engineers work with aircraft. They are involved primarily in designing aircraft and propulsion systems and in studying the aerodynamic performance of aircraft and construction materials. They work with the theory, technology, and practice of flight within the Earth's atmosphere.

\$85,000-160,000 per year



CIVIL ENGINEERING

Civil engineers design major transportation projects. Civil engineers conceive, design, build, supervise, operate, construct and maintain infrastructure projects and systems in the public and private sector, including roads, buildings, airports, tunnels, dams, bridges, and systems for water supply and sewage treatment.

\$65,000-108,000 per year



INDUSTRIAL ENGINEERING

Industrial engineers find ways to eliminate wastefulness in production processes. They devise efficient systems that integrate workers, machines, materials, information, and energy to make a product or provide a service.

\$60,000-135,000 per year

REQUIREMENTS

No required middle school classes needed.
Upon acceptance, must take high school Honors/AP Level Math Courses, Honors/AP Level Science Courses, and 2 Years of World Language.
